

## Reporting Water Pollution

We all can play a part in keeping our lakes, rivers, and streams clean. One way is to report activities that are causing water pollution.

### What kind of activities should you report?

- Contamination to lakes, rivers, and streams
- Pollution entering a storm drain or surface waer
- Suspicious dumping to drains and/or surface waters
- Suspicious discharges from pipes
- Large numbers of dead fish
- Construction site soil erosion entering surface waters
- Polluted stormwater runoff from storage piles and dumpsters



### Please provide the following information when you call:

- Your name and phone number (you can remain anonymous if you choose)
- The source of pollution and what was spilled or dumped
- Quantity of spill (if known)
- Body of water impacted
- When the spill occurred (if known)
- Major crossroads of spill or known address
